Selectmen Linda Saari, Clarence Farwell, Kevin Gorgoglione and Jack Flanagan were present.

Master Plan

Valerie Maurer was present to request a letter of support for our application for assistance to the UNH Cooperative Extension. The planning board is asking for assistance on the “Vision” and “Land Use” chapters of the Master Plan. Estimated cost is \$750. They will prepare a survey for residents to complete and conduct initial meetings. Valerie said Alan Rosenberg has talked to NRPC and TF Moran for costs to complete the two chapters by the end of the year. **Kevin** agreed to be the contact person on the Master Plan Committee. **Jack moved, seconded by Clarence to authorize Linda to sign the letter of support. Voted yes 4-0.**

Minutes

Jack moved, seconded by Clarence to approve the minutes of March 29th. Voted yes 4-0.

Energy Grant

Clarence said some of the ballasts in the library have been replaced so shouldn't need replacing when lighting is upgraded.

Chapel

An email was received from Rev. Johnson asking if he could put a small lawn sign outside the chapel to advertise Sunday Mass. The Selectmen agreed he could put out a sandwich board 24 hours before Mass and remove it following the service.

Three quotes were received for drilling a new well at the Chapel/Brusch Hall site:
Skillings & Sons, Inc., \$6,815, minus 5% after Clarence talked to them (\$6,474);
Capital Well Co., Inc., \$6,985;
Contoocook Artesian Well Co., \$6,735.

Jack asked whether Clarence had checked with Capital and Contoocook a second time. **Clarence** said no. **Clarence moved, seconded Kevin to award the contract to Skillings & Sons per their proposal. Estimated amount is \$6,474.25. Voted yes 4-0.**

Averill Rd/Cleveland Hill Rd

An email was received from Tim Ganos asking for a street light at the intersection of Averill Road and Cleveland Hill Road for safety reasons. **Jack** suggested the police chief and road agent look at the site and make a recommendation.

Police

Linda announced that the police department will be hosting Rape Aggression Defense training on April 13th, 14th, 20th and 21st from 6 go 9 pm. The cost is \$20 and will take place at CSDA. The course is to teach women defensive concepts and techniques against various types of assaults. People should contact Chief Goulden if interested.

Ambulance Generator

Kinney Towing & Transportation Inc. will do an annual maintenance service on the ambulance generator for \$254.37 vs. \$655 for Southworth-Milton Inc. **Clarence moved, seconded by Kevin to go with Kinney's quote of \$254.37. Voted yes 4-0.**

The Selectmen signed the Paramedic Training Agreement between Francis Gavin and the Ambulance Service.

Zoning Board of Adjustment

Kevin moved, seconded by Jack to reappoint Marcia Farwell as a member of the ZBA until March 31, 2013. Voted yes 4-0.

Monius property – H-42

Clarence said Meridian Land Services is working on a conceptual plan on the Monius property. It should be ready this week.

Non Public Session

Linda moved, seconded by Clarence to go into non public session under RSA 91-A: 3, II (a) for two issues. Voted yes 4-0.
