Minutes

*Board of Selectmen*

*Monday, April 26, 2010*

Selectmen Linda Saari, Clarence Farwell, Kevin Gorgoglione, Tad Putney and Jack Flanagan were present.

**Non Public Session**

*Linda moved, seconded by Kevin to go into non public session under RSA 91-A: 3, II, (c). Voted yes 5-0.*

Overseer of Welfare **Ann Webb** was present to review the monthly rate for mortgage or rent payments. Ann recommended the amount be changed from \$800 to \$900 per month for a family. The amount of \$400 for an individual will stay the same. *Jack moved, seconded by Kevin to change the monthly family limit to \$900 and keep the individual limit at \$400. Voted yes 5-0.*

**Ann** said she has appointed as assistant that volunteered to help families with budgeting. She said she can appoint an assistant by law.

At this point the selectmen returned to public session.

It was decided there was no need to seal the minutes.

**Ann** said she has a food pantry set up in the annex. She said most of the supplies were donated at the fund raiser they had at the Brookline Auction Gallery. Ann said it's for emergency use for families in need. She said about \$1,000 in checks have been donated.

**Cable**

**Linda** said not all voices are being picked up by the mikes in the meeting room. **Rena** was asked to have Chris & Rosie check on them.

**Surveillance System**

**Loring** said he would be in on May 10<sup>th</sup> with the proposals for the surveillance system.

**Library**

**Ann Somers** asked who is responsible for the exterior of the library. She sent an email of the work she and Loring have been doing to improve the landscaping around the building. It was agreed she should bring her recommendations to the library trustees and get their feedback.

**Safety Complex**

Ann should also get feedback from Wes Whittier on any landscaping she and Loring would like to do at the Safety Complex.

**Transportation Enhancement Grant**

**Tad** said the TE Grant application for the 4,800 feet of sidewalk on Milford Street and Main Street has been placed on the “reserve list.” He said the Commissioner disregarded the DOT and NRPC rankings of the project. A letter has been sent to the Commissioner to consider the rankings in his decision.

**Termite Control**

Two proposals were received for termite control at the town hall. Last year dead termites were discovered:

**JP Pest Services** of Milford in the amount of \$2,082.50 and the second year for \$337.50 for the Sentricon system; and

**Southern NH Pest Control** of Nashua in the amount of \$1,920 and the second year for \$300 for the Exterra system.

The selectmen agreed to wait and see if the problem returns this year.

**Lions Club Dinner**

**Linda** mentioned that Tad will be honored as one of the unsung heroes at the Lions Club Spaghetti Dinner in May.

**Police Station**

**Tad** said we should receive notice this week whether any federal funds will be available for the police addition to the safety complex.

**Averill Rd/Cleveland Hill Rd Intersection**

**Linda** suggested we start with reflectors to see if it helps at the intersection of Averill Road and Cleveland Hill Road. We are waiting for Jerry’s recommendation.

**Gen. Business**

Approved warrants for payment.
