Selectmen Linda Saari, Clarence Farwell, Kevin Gorgoglione, Tad Putney and Jack Flanagan were present.

**Surveillance System**

**Loring Webster, Acting Chief Mike Kurland and Brad Baker** were present. **Loring** said he met with Mike last Friday. They reviewed the three proposals. Since that time Brad Baker has volunteered to review the proposals and make recommendations. Brad is an expert in evaluating these systems and deals with them on a daily basis. **Mike** said he will work on a draft policy for the use of the tapes for June 1<sup>st</sup>. That will give him time to check on policies of other departments and get input from the officers. He said Hollis has audio in some areas of the PD. **Brad** said typically the tapes are kept for 31 days. He said we need to think about potential liability issues if we record audio. Brad said we'll have to factor camera replacement and maintenance into the budget. **Loring** said there will not be audio in the squad room or lunch area and not on the main level. It was agreed they will come back on June 7<sup>th</sup> with the proposals and a recommendation.

**Police**

**Mike** said the new cruiser is here.

He said DARE is done for the year. The pizza party will be held Wednesday at CSDA. The DARE group will be going to the Fisher Cats game on June 5<sup>th</sup>. The selectmen need to let Mike know soon if they will attend.

Mike said he will be reviewing mutual aid agreement with other towns tomorrow.

He said he's okay with coverage and Lt. Aucoin of the state police has offered to assist the town in emergency situations.

**Linda** signed the form for NH Police Standards & Training for Mike Kurland as Interim Police Chief.

**Linda** noted that we received a letter from Municipal Resources Inc (MRI) offering help with the police department if needed.
