Selectmen Linda Saari, Clarence Farwell, Kevin Gorgoglione and Jack Flanagan were present.

Linda expressed sympathy to the Yandell family on the loss of Abby over the weekend.

Minutes

Kevin moved, seconded by Jack to approve the minutes of June 21st. Voted yes 4-0.

Milford District Court

It was noted that Mont Vernon voted not to pay their share to keep Milford District Court open for the next year. Amherst is voting tonight on whether to fund their share. **Jack** questioned whether we should contact our state representatives and senator to consider moving the court to the State Police Troop B Barracks in Milford, a state owned vacant building. The others agreed it's a good idea but as of July 1st the Milford Court has no funds to lease the present Milford District Court building.

Roads

Linda said she spoke to Paul Sanderson at the Local Government Center. The Road Agent can set policies adopted by the Board of Selectmen for maintaining town roads. There is no "duty" to use salt on the roads. Paul suggested that we have a written snow and ice policy that can be modeled using the one of the DOT website as a template. The Road Agent and Board of Selectmen are protected under RSA 32:104 and 31:105.

Conservation Commission – H-126-1

Bob Parodi submitted documents for Linda's signature for the purchase of the Ballou property, lot # H-126-1.

July 4th Parade

Clarence said the Board is invited to participate in the parade on July 4th at 11 a.m. The Grand Marshall will be 101 year old Bob Flannery.
