Selectmen Linda Saari, Clarence Farwell, Tad Putney and Jack Flanagan were present.

Video Surveillance System

Loring Webster said the video surveillance system will be installed next week.

Tad moved, seconded by Jack to approve the General Order for use of the Video Surveillance System with minor changes. Voted yes 4-0.

Minutes

Tad moved, seconded by Jack to approve the minutes of August 2nd. Voted yes 4-0.

Clarence moved, seconded by Tad to approve the non public session minutes of August 2nd. Voted yes 4-0.

MS-5

The Selectmen signed the MS-5 (2009 Financial Report) prepared by the auditors.

Town Hall

An estimate to replace the two exterior doors by the police department was received from George Razzaboni. The amount is \$1,350 per door for steel doors with a window. **Mike Kurland** said there is an issue with the door by the police entrance. **Clarence** said he would talk to George about fixing it rather than replacing it.

Police Dept.

An estimate of \$750 was received from Absolute Mechanical Systems for an exhaust system in the evidence room of the police department.

Mike said HB 1267 is before the legislation to allow ordinances on solicitations and criminal background checks by the state police. He said he talked to the Hudson police chief and they are planning to charge a fee to offset the cost of the background check.

Police Chief Search Committee

Jack reported that the committee will conduct final interviews with candidates next Monday, the 16th. They hope to bring their recommendations of 3-5 people to the selectmen on August 23rd.

SRTS Sidewalk Grant

Tad said the base coat is on the Milford Street sidewalk. They will work on the Townsend Hill Road sidewalk and then put the final coat on both sidewalks.

Eagle Scout Project

Connor Sandin was present to say he's looking for a community Eagle Scout project. **Tad** said the conservation commission just purchased a piece of property on Route 130. **Rena** mentioned that we were looking to build a bulletin board on the Bond Street portico of the town hall which would help the wind from blowing through. **Ann Somers** mentioned that the exterior signs at the town hall and library need attention.

Non Public Session

Linda moved, seconded by Tad to go into non public session under RSA 91-A, e, II, (a) and (c). Voted yes 4-0.
