### Recent Happenings...

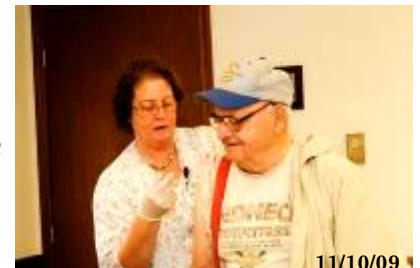
■ **Nov. 10th** Flu Shot clinic at Brusch Hall, many turned out for the convenience of receiving their flu shot in town (see pictures below).
