### STEERING COMMITTEE

In June of 2010, a group of dedicated residents began meeting monthly to help guide the Master Plan Update process.

### COMMUNITY FORUM

A Community Forum was held on October 20, 2010 at RMMS. Residents participated in facilitated small group discussions on topics that will be addressed in the Master Plan.

### MASTER PLAN SURVEY

Distributed electronically and in hard copy during the fall of 2010, the survey gave residents an additional opportunity to voice their opinion.

### CHAPTERS IN PROGRESS

Drafts of the Vision, Land Use, Natural Resources, and Energy chapters are currently being reviewed. Work begins this month on 3 new chapters—Economic Development, Cultural & Historic Resources, and Transportation.
