Library Community Room Use Policy
July 12, 2005

The Library meeting room shall be available on a first-come, first-served basis to non-profit groups and organizations engaged in educational, cultural, intellectual or charitable activities that are open to the public. This is in accordance with Article VI of the Library Bill of Rights which states that such facilities should be made available to the public served "on an equitable basis, regardless of the beliefs or affiliations of individuals or groups requesting their use." Library programs shall take precedence over all other requests for use. Bookings for the meeting room shall be made with the circulation desk. Frequency of use by any group shall be determined by community demand. There shall be no fee charged for the use of the meeting room. However, a fee may be charged for the use of the kitchen facilities or other equipment. The Library does not advocate or endorse the viewpoints of meeting or meeting room users.
