Zoning Amendment

Are you in favor of adopting the proposed workforce housing zoning amendment, which adds a new section to the Town's Zoning Ordinance, entitled **Workforce Housing Option**? The purpose of this subsection is to comply with NH RSA 674:58-61 and to provide an option for workforce housing, subject to certain requirements. The amendment permits a higher density for workforce housing units, reduces frontage and limits the workforce housing units to 1,500 square feet and two bedrooms among other items. In the absence of this zoning amendment, the Superior Court could grant a developer an expedited favorable review and construct workforce housing without local review.

The Planning Board approves of this amendment.
